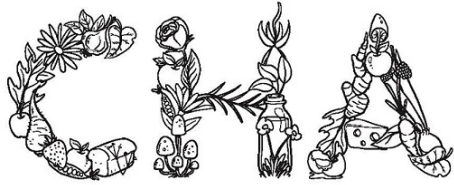

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) programs enable community members to partner with a farm to “buy shares” of farm produce over a growing year, helping to ensure that the farm can remain operational. In a CSA program, the members receive a share of the farm’s produce, meat, eggs, herbs, etc. weekly depending on what is available.
